

# McCullough Robertson Endowed Scholarship for Law Students

The McCullough Robertson Endowed Scholarship for Law Students aims to encourage and support undergraduate students from social, physical or economic disadvantaged background to undertake studies in law at The University of Queensland.

The Scholarship will provide assistance to disadvantaged domestic students currently enrolled **full-time** in the Bachelor of Laws (Honours) or Bachelor of Laws program (including dual programs).

The Scholarship will take the form of monetary assistance to help with living expenses for 12 months and will be paid in two instalments – one during Semester 1 and one during Semester 2. Payments will be made after the relevant Census Date. The value of each scholarship will not be less than \$3000.

To be eligible to apply you must be a domestic student enrolled full-time in the LLB or LLB (Hons) (including dual programs) that can demonstrate social, physical or economic disadvantage.

Applicants will be assessed by a selection committee comprising the Academic Dean & Head of the TC Beirne School of Law (or nominee), the Deputy Dean of the TC Beirne School of Law (or nominee), and a representative of the McCullough Robertson Foundation Ltd. Applicants will be assessed on the following criteria:

- academic merit; and
- demonstrated disadvantage including social, physical or economic; and
- personal qualities
