





Arc of Professionalism...


- You are early legal professionals right now

Before you post...

- Online social media has challenged the concepts of "public" and "private"
- Professional boundaries ("friends" colleagues, clients, acquaintances)
- What is the destiny of the data?
 - * How much control do you have over the information once you post it?
- Are your privacy settings adequate?
- What about your "friends" privacy settings?
- Are you maintaining professional standards online?
 - * are you familiar with your employer's media/internet usage policy?
 - *does your professional regulator have a "social media" guideline/policy?
 - *one moment of rashness could have unintended consequences not only for you

Used by prospective employers...


- Cyber-vetting in Recruitment
 - How large is your online footprint
 - What does it say about you
 - Do you always have a glass in your hand?
- Increased use of "Google" search and other social media searches in recruitment and scholarship / post graduate entry decisions
- Considerations:-
 - * privacy principles collection/use
 - * discrimination

- Core of Identity

 - Also what others imagine you to be




- John Proctor refuses to sign a false confession,
