#### PROFESSOR TIM DUNNE

PRO-VICE-CHANCELLOR
THE UNIVERSITY OF QUEENSLAND

Tim brings to the role 25 years of experience as researcher, educator and academic leader. His most recent appointment was Executive Dean of the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences at The University of Queensland (UQ). Tim was the first Dean of the new Faculty after its inauguration in 2014; under his leadership, the Faculty has established itself as among the very best in Australia and competitive internationally across many disciplinary areas. Prior to his four-year term as Dean, Tim was the Director of UQ's Asia Pacific Centre for the Responsibility to Protect (R2P) as well as Professor of International Relations in the School of Political Science (which has remained his substantive position since he joined UQ in 2010). He previously held discipline and faculty-level leadership roles at the University of Exeter (UK). Tim began his career at Aberystwyth University in Wales, which is famous for having the oldest and one of the best departments of International Relations in the world. His graduate training was completed at the University of Oxford.

He is internationally recognised for his work on human rights protection and foreign policy-making in a changing world order. He has written and edited twelve books, including a prize-winning work on The Globalization of International Society (2017) co-edited with Christian Reus-Smit. Tim is an elected Fellow of the Academy of Social Sciences Australia.



### HONOURABLE JUSTICE SARAH DERRINGTON

#### **GUEST SPEAKER**

The Honourable Justice Sarah Derrington was appointed President of the Australian Law Reform Commission and a Judge of the Federal Court of Australia from 10 January 2018.

Prior to her appointment, Justice Derrington was Professor and Dean of Law at The University of Queensland and a barrister specialising in maritime and shipping law, general commercial law and arbitration.

Justice Derrington is a Director of the Australian Maritime College (AMC), a member of the Australasian Institute of Judicial Administration (AIJA), the Commonwealth's Admiralty Rules Committee, the Council of the Australian National Maritime Museum (ANMM) and is a Fellow of the Nautical Institute and of the Australian Academy of Law. She served as a Director of the Australian Maritime Safety Authority (AMSA) from 2012 until December 2017 and is a past President of the Maritime Law Association of Australia and New Zealand (MLAANZ). She was elected as a Titular Member of the Comité Maritime International in 2016 and continues to chair the International Working Group on Cross-border Insolvency.

Justice Derrington has published in leading international journals in the field of marine insurance and carriage of goods by sea and, with James M Turner QC of the English Bar, co-authored The Law & Practice of Admiralty Matters, now in its second edition (OUP, 2016). She was the co-Editor of the Queensland Reports from July 2011 until May 2015.
