

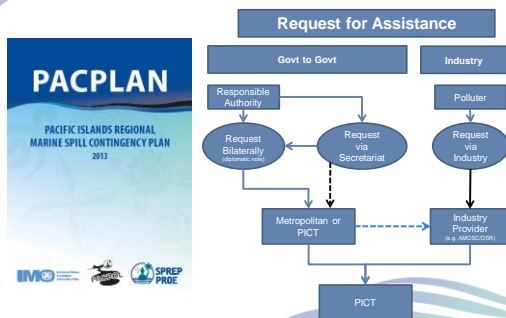

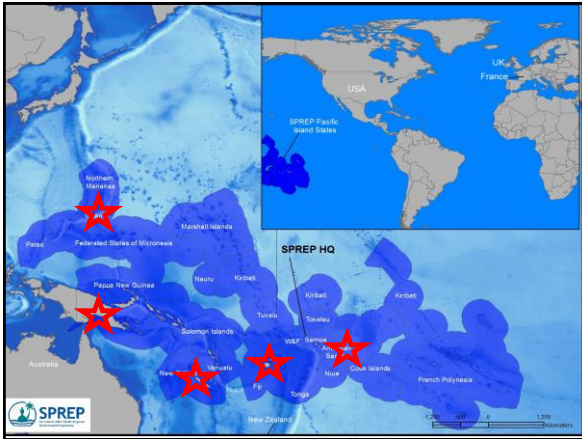

Mutual Aid Case: WWII WRECKS

- 13 million tonnes of shipping sunk in the Pacific in WWII
- Britain (1940 vessels), Japan (3322 vessels) and the US (1022 vessels)
- Regional Strategy in place to address WWII Wrecks
- USS Mississinewa – Ulithi Atoll 9Mil Litres recovered




Mutual Aid Case: Oil Spill Response Equipment - Fiji





- \$858K for oil spill response equipment for Fiji
- Storage, Training, storage, maintenance
- Risk Assessment for Marine Pollution
- Partners – Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade NZ, Maritime Safety Authority of Fiji, Maritime New Zealand



Mutual Aid Response: SPREP Core Fund

- Australia - biggest SPREP donor
- 21% overall budget in 2017 – US \$2.5Mil
- 8% overall budget for 2018/19 – US \$4.1Mil
- For the WMPC Division funds 75% of the positions
- Director, Hazardous Waste Management Adviser, Pollution Adviser
- 36% (2017), 11% (2018), 15% (2019) of SPREP Outcomes

- Two year Secondment
- Invaluable contribution marine pollution work
- SIDS Conference
- PACPOL Review
- RRFP
- Linkage to other SPREP programmes
- Regional IMO TCP Activities



Challenges and ISSUES

- Distance and coverage – monitoring
- Reporting – non existent **
- Change in Guards - Maritime Administrations and OC's
- Infrastructure capacity – maintenance
- Human and Institutional Capacity - Legislation & Signatory to IMO OPRC Convention



Review Process

- Review workshops, June – Mar 2019
 - Australia – June 2018
 - NZ – Dec 2018
 - France & Territories – Dec 2018
 - U.S.A. – Dec 2018
- Provide draft to all members by Dec 2018 for feedback by Jan 2019
- Final draft by March 2019
- Launch of the Final PACPLAN Draft at SPILLCON 2019 Perth May, 2019
- Endorsement at the 29SM Apia Samoa 2019
- Publication made available October 2019
