

APPLICATIONS are called for the UNIVERSITY OF QUEENSLAND LAW SOCIETY MEDAL FOR OUTSTANDING ACHIEVEMENT 2019

- The most outstanding graduate will be selected by the Head of the Law School after consultation with the President of the University of Queensland Law Society.
- Eligible students are those who will graduate, or have graduated, in 2019 and who satisfy the following criteria:
 - (i) have an overall GPA of at least 5.5 in all completed LAWS courses; and
 - (ii) have been positively and actively involved in -
 - (a) the life of the Law School or the Society; and
 - (b) the broader community; and
 - (iii) do not hold the office of the President of the University of Queensland Law Society.
- The award will be made to the applicant with the best overall performance in the criteria listed above.
- The prize is a cast medal and inscription on the honour board displayed in the Law Library.
- Applications for the prize should be lodged no later than 5.00pm on 23 November 2019. Applications should be in the form of a letter addressing the criteria. The letter should be addressed to the Head of School and forwarded to scholarships@law.uq.edu.au.
