Contract	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. If a student has done LAWS1001 and not LAWS1003 → will need to do LAWS2112 Law of Contract B 2. If a student had done LAWS1003 and not LAWS1001 → will need to do LAWS2111 Law of Contract A
Property	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. If a student has done LAWS3009 and not LAWS3011 → will need to do LAWS3112 Law of Property B 2. If a student has done LAWS3011 and not LAWS3009 → will need to do LAWS3111 Law of Property A
Criminal	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. If a student has done LAWS2004 and not LAWS2006 → will need to do LAWS2114 Criminal Law & Procedure B <i>(NB – this is a change from LAWS2006 #1 to LAWS2114 #2)</i> 2. If a student has done LAWS2006 and not LAWS2004 → will need to do LAWS2113 Criminal Law & Procedure A
Constitutional	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. If a student has done LAWS2005 and not LAWS2007 → will need to do LAWS1115 Principles of Public Law <i>(NB – this is a change from LAWS2007 #1 to LAWS1115 #2)</i> 2. If a student has done LAWS2007 and not LAWS2005 → will need to do LAWS1116 Constitutional Law
Equity & Trusts	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. If a student has done LAWS3010 and not LAWS3012 → will need to do LAWS3113 Law of Trusts A 2. If a student has done LAWS3012 and not LAWS3010 → will need to do LAWS3114 Law of Trusts B
Company & Insolvency	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. If a student has done LAWS5017 and not LAWS5019 → will need to do LAWS4112 Corporate Law <i>(NB – this is a change from LAWS5019 #1 to LAWS4112 #2. In 2008 LAWS5019 will still be offered, so students should do this if they have already completed LAWS5017)</i> 2. If a student has done LAWS5019 and not LAWS5017 → will need to do LAWS4112 Corporate Law
Administrative Law	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. If a student has done LAWS5018 and not LAWS5020 → will need to do LAWS1115 Principles of Public Law <i>(NB – this is a change from LAWS5020 #1 to LAWS1115 #2. In 2008 LAWS5020 will still be offered, so students should do this if they have already completed LAWS5018)</i> 2. If a student has done LAWS5020 and not LAWS5018 → will need to do LAWS2115 Administrative Law
