

Using the Supreme Court Library – a guide for UQ students during 2016

- **Location: level 12 of the QEII Courts of Law 415 George Street**
- **Hours: 8:30am to 5:00pm during business days**

Facilities

- Free WiFi is available throughout the library
 - Users of library ICT resources must accept that use of these resources is subject to the full range of Australian laws as well as any other relevant library policies and rules, including (but not limited to) those relating to copyright, breach of confidence, defamation, privacy, contempt of court, bullying and cyber-bullying, harassment, vilification, anti-discrimination, wilful damage and computer hacking.
- The library has a small number of study rooms which students are welcome to use subject to availability; students are also very welcome to use any of the reading tables or study carrels and the Reading Deck at the Western end of the library.

Restrictions

- As study space in the library is limited, access is only available for post graduate law students and undergraduate law students in their 3rd, 4th or 5th year of study.
- The library is used by judges, associates, barristers, solicitors and litigants in person, so a level of decorum and consideration for other library users is required and enforced
- Students should wear smart/casual clothes when using the library. (e.g. trousers/skirt rather than shorts; trainers/shoes rather than thongs)
- Mobile phone calls should not be made or taken within the public areas of the library
- Consumption of food is not permitted within the library
- Books or other print materials may not be removed from the library premises, as there is no lending of hard copy materials (which are at the disposal of the judiciary)
- Please minimise photocopying: scan/save/email required resources digitally wherever possible
